## **EDUCATION POLICY**

### **Buctouche MicMac Band**

The Council of the Buctouche MicMac Band believes that the quality of education must not be compromised under any circumstance, as it provides the key to our future through our future leadership – our children.

The Band does not have a school located on the reserve and:

#### **Registration**

Registration is the responsibility of the Parent(s).

This department is responsible for the timely provision of tuition related statistics (ie Nominal Roll) to AANDC.

#### **Transportation**

The Buctouche MicMac Band is responsible for ensuring and maintaining adequate transportation for students.

The Buctouche MicMac Band provides transportation for all its students from K to 12, to their respective school locations.

Students are bussed to schools that are located in Buctouche and Rexton.

#### **Post Secondary Education**

Post Secondary Education is administered on behalf of the Buctouche MicMac Band by the North Shore Mic Mac District Council (NSMDC).

#### **Pre-School/ Daycare**

The Buctouche MicMac Band has a Headstart/Daycare Centre located on the First Nation, that is administered by Child and Family Services and is responsible for intake and day to day operations.

#### **Tuition Agreement**

The Buctouche MicMac Band currently has an Enhanced Tuition Agreement with the Province of New Brunswick.
